

Call for Proposals for Small Conference Sponsorship

As part of its new outreach effort, the ARIA Board of Directors has established a “Small Conference Sponsorship” program. The intent of this program is to encourage the organization of new conferences or symposia that would attract scholars conducting research in areas related to risk and insurance (e.g., economics, finance), and increase awareness of ARIA. Conference organizers would receive some monetary support (up to \$5,000 plus waivers on JRI and RMIR submission fees for papers resulting from the conference) to help defray costs. In turn, the conference organizers would acknowledge ARIA’s sponsorship in all conference communications.

The Board is now seeking proposals for conferences to be sponsored under this program. Proposals for conferences/symposia must include the following information:

- Title, location, and dates
- Statement of purpose including the theme/topic areas
- Explicitly indicate how the conference will heighten ARIA’s exposure to the research community
- Participants (including target group, number, and method of soliciting)
- Organizer(s) contact information and qualifications
- Amount requested with budget/justification
- Other funding sources (if applicable)
