Academicians, PhD students, and other researchers are encouraged to submit a proposal to present their best research. Papers on any risk or insurance related topics are welcome. Specific subject areas include, but are not limited to, insurance economics, risk management, behavioral risk perception, law and regulation of insurance and risk transfer mechanisms, insurance accounting, insurance operations, corporate governance, health insurance and economics, public policy, financing of aging and retirement.

Executive summaries (not exceeding four pages) that focus on the purpose, expected results, and importance of the research may be submitted. Completed papers are preferred. Proposals from doctoral students are encouraged.

**The deadline for submission is February 15, 2019.** This deadline will not be extended. **Proposals must be submitted electronically using the link below in Acrobat (pdf) or Word (.docx) format. Please remove all author information from your paper (double-blind review process).**
