Nanyang Business School is hosting a multi-year Cyber Risk Management Project which is a Public-Private Partnership between Nanyang Technological University, the Monetary Authority of Singapore, the Cyber Security Agency of Singapore, and leading global insurance companies. The candidate is expected to contribute to the ongoing research efforts in cyber risk management and financing of catastrophe risks, and to publish academic papers in high-quality actuarial science, risk management and insurance, business and finance journals.
