

Assistant or Associate Professor of Insurance Fall 2018

The Department of Economics, Finance and Insurance at the University of Hartford invites applications for a tenure track assistant or associate professor position in Insurance beginning Fall 2018. Applicants should have a Ph.D. in Insurance and Risk Management. Advanced ABD candidates will be considered. The successful candidate will be expected to deliver excellent teaching at both the undergraduate and graduate level (on campus and online), conduct high quality research, render the usual service required of faculty in institutions of higher education, and be committed to working with a diverse body of students. Recent teaching experience is required. Applicants should be prepared to teach foundational courses such as Principles of Insurance, and in specialty areas such as Employee Benefits or Social Insurance. There will also be opportunities to teach in our innovative, University Interdisciplinary Studies (UIS) curriculum.
