The Department of Finance, Insurance and Law in the College of Business seeks a tenure-track scholar at the Assistant Professor level to begin August 16, 2018 with research and teaching interest in Risk Management and Insurance. Qualified candidates hold a Ph.D. in Finance, Insurance or a business-related field. ABDs will be considered if close to completion. For teaching positions, state law mandates demonstrable oral proficiency in the English language as a requirement for this position. The primary teaching need is at the undergraduate level, face-to-face or online, and graduate instruction is possible. Salary is competitive. The anticipated teaching load for this 9-month position is three courses or the equivalent per semester. Average department class size is 29 students.
