The College of Business at Florida State University is seeking applicants to fill a tenure-track position in Risk Management and Insurance. The anticipated start date is Fall 2018. The position will be filled at the assistant or associate level; however, experience is preferred.

Close interaction among students, faculty members, alumni and the business community continues to be a hallmark of the program.
