The Henry W. Bloch School of Management at the University of Missouri-Kansas City (UMKC) invites applications for the new Lockton Chair of Risk Management and Insurance beginning in Fall 2018. Rank (Associate or Full Professor) will be based upon qualifications and experience.

We seek applicants with a doctorate in risk management and/or insurance, finance, economics, or closely related areas and a substantial and continuing record of publications on risk management or insurance in top academic journals. Successful candidates will demonstrate a strong commitment to teaching excellence at the MBA, EMBA, MSF and undergraduate levels, be able to contribute to the future growth of the department and school, establish new and nurture existing relationships with external constituencies, and interact effectively with members of the local business community. Salary and benefits will be competitive with those at leading business schools and support for conducting research will be provided.

This new position at the Bloch School of Management offers several important benefits:

- The position provides the opportunity to shape the direction of a new risk management and insurance program within a growing finance department.
- The occupant will have a competitive teaching load with support for summer research and travel.
