Arcadia University invites applications for a tenure track Assistant Professorship in Actuarial Science starting September 2018.

Arcadia University's Actuarial Science Program is housed in the Department of Computer Science and Mathematics. We offer classes to prepare students for exams P, FM, and SRM of the Society of Actuaries as well as for the three V.E.E. courses, and anticipate expanding the program to prepare students for additional exams. The number of majors in actuarial science has grown from eight to 48 in four years.

Our priority is strong teaching; we seek someone with the ability and enthusiasm to teach a wide variety of courses, including courses to prepare students for Exams P, FM, and the new Statistics for Risk Modeling (SRM) exam of the Society of Actuaries. Actuarial credentials from the Society of Actuaries or Casualty Actuarial Society would be especially valued.

A Ph.D. in actuarial science, risk management, statistics, or mathematics, demonstrated excellence in and commitment to teaching, and an ongoing research program are required. (ABD will be considered)
